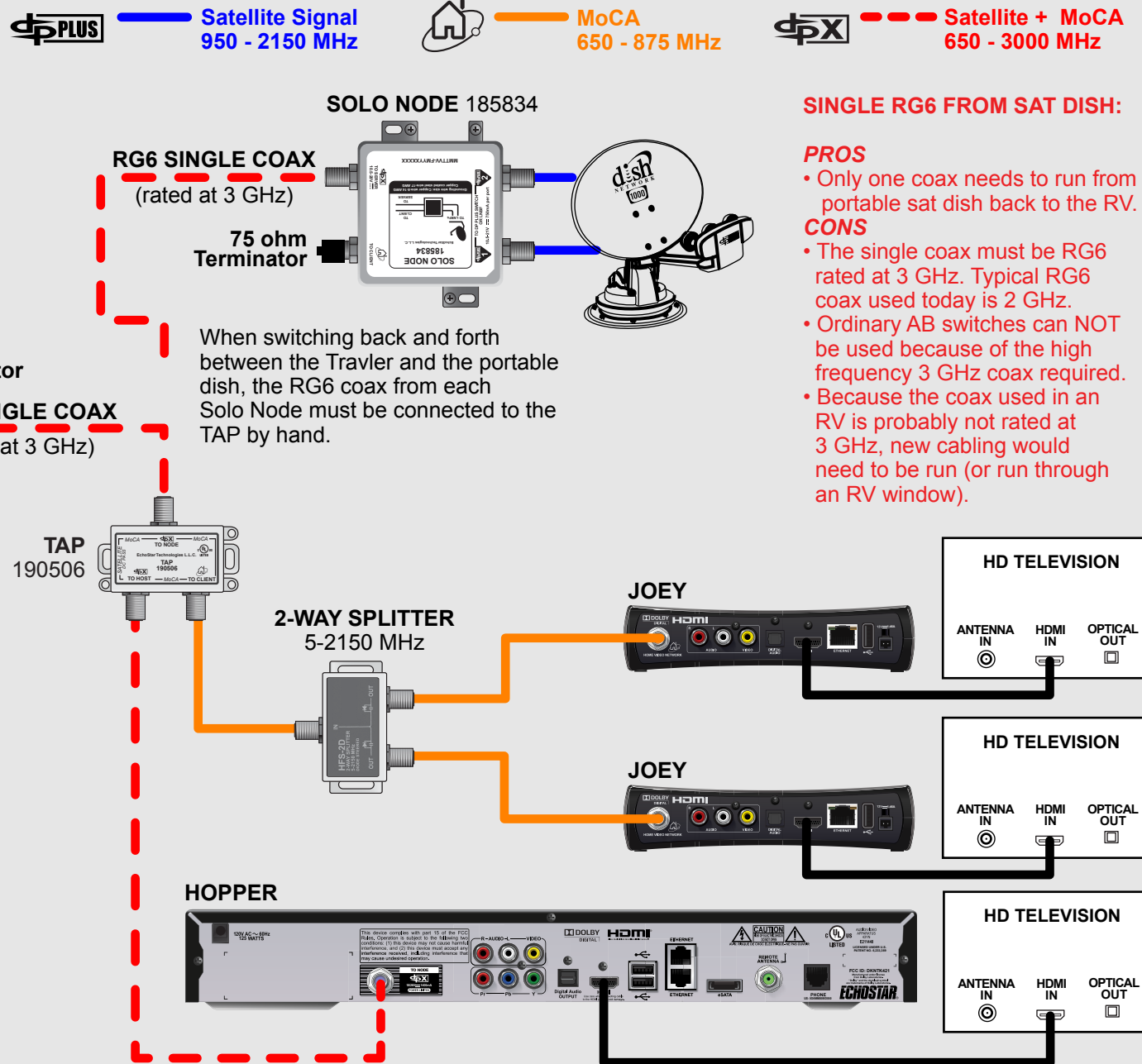


EQUIPMENT AT THE TRIPOD

SINGLE RG6 FROM SAT DISH:

PROS

- Only one coax needs to run from a portable sat dish back to the RV.

CONS

- The single coax must be RG6 rated at 3 GHz. Typical RG6 coax used today is 2 GHz.
- Ordinary AB switches can NOT be used because of the high frequency 3 GHz coax required.
- Because the coax used in an RV is probably not rated at 3 GHz, new cabling would need to be run (or run through an RV window).
